## WASHTENAW COUNTY

Washtenaw County's *Office of Community & Economic Development (OCED)* offers free *Home Improvement Programs* that fall into several categories: rehabilitation, weatherization, and energy optimizing services to income eligible homeowners. The *Home Rehabilitation Program* uses federal HUD funds to help bring eligible properties into compliance with housing standards. The specific programs under this service are an *Accessibility Ramp Program*, a *Critical Repair Program*, and a *Roof Replacement program*. It is on a first-come, first-served basis. The *Home Weatherization Program* offers air sealing within attics/foundations; insulation for crawlspaces, attics and walls; and to help repair/replace furnaces, hot water heaters, and refrigerators. The application can be printed from the website and returned to the OCED office. Contact (734) 544-3008 for eligibility or application questions. The *Furnace Test and Tune Program* falls under Washtenaw County's energy services and is in partnership with DTE to help homeowners with furnace repairs, installation of programmable energy saving thermostats, etc. Call (734) 544-3005 to have an application mailed to you.
